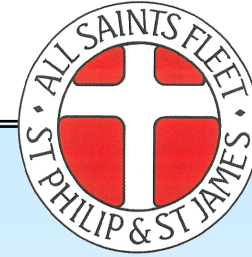

Pastoral Care
